Vabilo k prijavi prispevkov

Vabimo vas, da se udeležite 14. mednarodnega Simpozija mladih slavistov z naslovom **Prostor in čas v slovanskih jezikih in literaturah**, ki bo potekal 25. in 26. novembra 2026 na Filozofski fakulteti Univerze v Ljubljani (Aškerčeva cesta 2, SI-1000 Ljubljana). Simpozij organizira Študentska sekcija Zveze slovenskih slavističnih društev v sodelovanju z Oddelkom za slovenistiko in Oddelkom za slavistiko Filozofske fakultete Univerze v Ljubljani.

Mednarodno srečanje je namenjeno vsem mladim, ki v svojih znanstvenih raziskavah obravnavajo teme s področja slovanskih jezikov, literatur, didaktike in prevodoslovja. K oddaji in predstavitvi prispevkov vabimo študentke in študente ter mlade doktorice in doktorje znanosti na slovenskih in tujih univerzah oz. vse, ki so univerzitetni študij že zaključili in se z razpisanimi temami strokovno ali znanstveno ukvarjajo.

Tematski sklopi

Letošnji simpozij poteka pod naslovom **Prostor in čas v slovanskih jezikih in literaturah**.

Predlagani tematski sklopi (možna je tudi kakšna druga tematika) so:

JEZIKOSLOVJE

- jezik zemljepisnega prostora: narečja, mestne govornice in regionalne različice
- jezik v stičišču prostorov: jezikovni stik in večjezičnost
- jezik družbenih prostorov: socialna zvrstnost, jezikovna variantnost in spremembe, sociolekti in diskurzi

- jezik v digitalnem prostoru: novi mediji, spletna komunikacija in jezikovne prakse
- jezik v času: diahrone spremembe in razvoj slovanskih jezikov
- jezik med generacijami: starostni sociolekti in medgeneracijska komunikacija
- slavistično jezikoslovje nekoč in danes: metode, raziskave in institucionalne razmere

LITERARNA VEDA

- književnost zemljepisnih prostorov: nacionalne, regionalne in narečne slovanske književnosti
- književnost družbenih prostorov: subkulture, manjšine, družbeno obrobje
- književnost v digitalnem prostoru: novi mediji, recepcija in transmedialnost
- književnost izbranega časa: literarna obdobja, tokovi in zgodovinski konteksti
- tematizacija prostora in časa v slovanskih književnostih
- literarni postopki upodabljanja prostora in časa
- slavistična literarna veda nekoč in danes: metode, raziskave in institucionalne razmere

- način obravnave specifičnih kurikularnih tem v povezavi s časom in prostorom v slovanskih jezikih in literaturah
- primerjalna analiza tradicionalnih in novejših metod poučevanja slovanskih jezikov in literatur
- prihodnost didaktike slovanskih jezikov in literatur – nova metodologija, institucionalne razmere
- izbrane teme iz didaktike slovanskih jezikov in literatur kot J2

Navodila za prijavo in oddajo povzetkov

Prijave s **prijavnim obrazcem**, **povzetkom** in **kratko predstavitvijo avtorja** sprejemamo na elektronskem naslovu studentska.sekcija@zdsds.si **do vključno 30. julija 2026**. O izboru prispevkov vas po elektronski pošti obvestimo najkasneje **do 7. avgusta 2026**.

Povzetek (od **250 do 350 besed**) in kratka predstavitev avtorja naj bosta v jeziku prispevka (**vsi slovanski jeziki ali angleščina**) in v angleščini; če je jezik prispevka angleščina, mora biti drugi povzetek v poljubnem slovanskem jeziku. Diskusija in komunikacija z udeleženci bosta potekali v slovenščini ali angleščini.

Članke za objavo v zborniku bo treba oddati **do vključno 14. septembra 2026**. Če bo recenzent pogojno sprejel prispevek in ta kljub popravkom ne bo ustrezal zahtevam znanstvenega pisanja, si pridržujemo pravico, da prispevka ne objavimo v zborniku. Predstavitev prispevka na simpoziju je omejena na 15 minut, sledi 5 minut za diskusijo.

Kotizacija za sodelovanje na znanstvenem srečanju za vse prijavljene znaša **25 €** in je v celoti namenjena pripravi zbornika. Stroške prevoza in prenočitve krijejo udeleženske in udeleženci sami. Space and Time in Slavic Languages and Literatures

Ljubljana, Slovenia; 25 and 26 November 2026

Call for applications

We invite you to participate in the 14th International Symposium of Young Slavists **Space and Time in Slavic Languages and Literatures**, which will take place on 25 and 26 November 2026 at the Faculty of Arts, University of Ljubljana (Aškerčeva 2, SI-1000 Ljubljana). The symposium is organised by the Student Section of the Slovenian Slavic Association, Department of Slovene Studies and Department of Slavistics at the Faculty of Arts of the University of Ljubljana.

The international meeting is aimed at all young people whose scientific research deals with topics in the field of Slavic languages, literatures, didactics and translation studies. We invite students and young PhDs at Slovenian and foreign universities, or all those who have already completed their university studies and are working on the topics of the call for papers, to submit and present their papers.

Thematic areas

This year's symposium is titled **Space and Time in Slavic Languages and Literatures**. The proposed thematic areas (other topics are also possible) are:

LINGUISTICS

- language in geographical space: dialects, urban dialects, and regional varieties
- language at the intersection of spaces: language contact and multilingualism
- language in social space: social variation, linguistic variation and change, sociolects, and discourses
- language in digital space: new media, online communication, and language practices

- language over time: diachronic changes and the development of Slavic languages
- language across generations: age sociolects and intergenerational communication
- Slavic linguistics then and now: methods, research, and institutional contexts

LITERARY STUDIES

- literature of geographical space: national, regional, and dialectal Slavic literatures
- literature of social space: subcultures, minorities, and social peripheries
- literature in the digital space: new media, reception, and transmediality
- literature of a selected time: literary periods, tendencies, and historical contexts
- the thematization of space and time in Slavic literatures
- literary techniques for depicting space and time
- Slavic literary studies past and present: methods, research, and institutional contexts

LANGUAGE DIDACTICS AND DIDACTICS OF LITERATURE

- development and chronological aspects of the didactics of Slavic languages and literatures
- the issue of historical didactics in Slavic languages and literatures
- cross-curricular integration in Slavic language instruction (in relation to the temporal and spatial aspects of subjects)
- approaches to addressing specific curricular topics in relation to time and space in Slavic languages and literatures
- a comparative analysis of traditional and more recent methods of teaching Slavic languages and literatures
- the future of the didactics of Slavic languages and literatures – new methodologies, institutional contexts
- selected topics in the didactics of Slavic languages and literatures as L2

Application procedure and submission of summaries

The applications consisting of the application form, a summary of the conference paper, and a short CV of the author should be sent electronically to studentska.sekcija@zdsds.si by no later than **30 July 2026**. The application form is found on the website of the Student Section of the Slavic Society of Slovenia. The applicants will be informed whether their topic has been accepted for presentation by **7 August 2026**.

The abstract (between 250 and 350 words) and the **short CV** must be written in both the language of the conference paper (any Slavic language or English) and in English. If the language of the paper is English, the second abstract must be written in a Slavic language. The organizers will communicate with the participants in Slovene and/or English.

The papers must be submitted by no later than **14 September 2026**. All papers will be anonymously reviewed and should be corrected thereafter by the participants. **If the reviewer conditionally accepts the contribution but the corrections which are subsequently made fail to raise the paper to the proper standards of scientific writing, we reserve the right of not publishing it in the symposium proceedings.** The time limit for presentations is 15 minutes, followed by 5 minutes for discussion, which will be in either Slovene or English.

The conference fee is **25 €**. The collected funds will be used to cover the costs of preparing the publication accompanying the symposium. We are unable to reimburse any expenses related to travel and accommodation.
